## PLANNING FOR THE FUTURE

Since the beginning of the COVID-19 pandemic, your GracePlace Leadership has weekly considered what does it look like for us to gather as a church family on a weekly basis. For a season, we understood the safest thing we could do for our church body was just to gather virtually. As State and Local Governments allowed a loosening of the stay at home mandates, we began to consider our alternatives again. It was at that time that we put into place the weekly outdoor gatherings as a means for those who were comfortable to come out of their homes and meet together. We have continued the virtual service for those who are not comfortable meeting in person, as well as providing the radio broadcast so that people could sit in their cars and experience the service. In the coming weeks, we are looking at opportunities to move our outdoor gatherings inside sometime this fall with appropriate protocols. Our plan would include continuing the virtual service for those who do not have a comfort level to meet in person as well as our live stream via FACEBOOK LIVE. These in-person gatherings will have a different look as we are considering all things necessary to stay safe by following a series of best practices. Here are some of the things that we are considering...

- Adults and kids 10 years or older, we would ask to wear a mask while you are in the building and during times of worship and singing.
- In the Auditorium or the Centre, we would ask that you bring your own chair. Plastic chairs are available for those who do not have their own chair. We would ask that there is appropriate social distance between

families and groups.

- No Kids Ministry will be available at this time, but we welcome children, even the energetic ones, to join us for worship. We just ask that they be accompanied by an adult at all times. Age appropriate kids packets filled with activities will be provided for kids.
- We are looking at overflow seating throughout the campus. Before leaving home, we would ask you to self-screen to confirm no signs of illness, particularly those associated with COVID-19. We would ask that you do not come to the GracePlace campus if you are experiencing the following symptoms: persistent cough; shortness of breath or difficulty breathing; fever, chills, shaking, body aches; headache or sore throat; and/or loss of taste or smell. We would like your feedback regarding this step and these safety measures.
